 - o Confirmed -The ALC works from the principle that nationally recognized, standardized prior learning assessment (PLA) options, such as CLEP, and institutionally recognized challenge exams will be inventoried

and thoroughly considered before institutions develop individualized assessments such as the portfolio option.
